To enable participants/aviation security auditors/inspectors to acquire the theoretical and practical knowledge necessary for conducting national audits, inspections and/or tests through the application of the relevant competencies and in accordance with Annex 17 – Aviation Security and the ICAO Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973 – Restricted).

Course Objectives:

The course aims to allow participants to:


- I. Determine monitoring elements contained in a National Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programme (NCASQCP) (NQCP);
- II. Describe the legal basis for security audits, inspections and tests;
- III. Define aviation security audits, inspections and tests;
- IV. Determine the duties and specific skills required by an auditor/inspector;
- V. Determine the appropriate national programme methodology for conducting quality assurance activities;

VI. Conduct the various aspects of a simulated aviation security inspection;

VII. Define effective Root Cause Analysis and resolution.

Target Audience:

- Participants should work for the State's appropriate authority responsible for aviation security, other regulatory authorities, airports, airlines, and/or other stakeholders that have an active role in their national aviation security quality control oversight programme (activities).
- Participants should have attended a specialized AVSEC training activity and/or have regulatory experience.
