- The Airports Authority of Trinidad and Tobago ("the Authority") was established by the Airports Authority of Trinidad and Tobago Act Chapter 49:02 of the laws of Trinidad and Tobago and is responsible for the development and management of its airport estates, including the maintenance and improvement of its 1. facilities, so as to ensure the availability of efficient, secure and safe aviation services and commercial viability.
- The Authority hereby invites suitably qualified firms to submit sealed bids for THE UPGRADE OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM AT AIRPORTS 2. ADMINISTRATION CENTRE, SOUTH TERMINAL, PIARCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

- 5. The Invitation to Bid (ITB) will only be issued electronically, to registered providers of the goods and services required, as listed in the Procurement Depository maintained by the Office of Procurement Regulation (OPR).

- 6. Bidder's representatives must attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting which will be held on site.
- The Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for THURSDAY 08TH JANUARY 2026 at 10:00 AM (AST) at the Airports Administration Centre, Piarco 7. International Airport, South Terminal, Golden Grove Road Piarco. Representatives attending the meeting in person must be outfitted with the necessary Safety Shoes and PPE gear.
- 8. The contract will be awarded in accordance with the pre-defined evaluation criteria and a scoring system outlined in the Invitation to Bid ("ITB") Document, THE UPGRADE OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM AT AIRPORTS ADMINISTRATION CENTRE, SOUTH TERMINAL, PIARCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.
- Bidders must submit a Bid Security in favour of the Authority marked to the value of **FIFTEEN THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO DOLLARS (TT\$15,200.00).** The Bid Security may be either, in the form of a certified manager's cheque or bond (in the Form of Bid Security contained in the 9 Bid document) established with a financial institution incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago and acceptable to the Authority.
